4. BACKGROUND AND HISTORY:

The purpose of this sole source procurement is to create a wadded measure to assess student learning loss due to adjustmentiathe 201920 and 202021 school years. Measuring impact on student achievement can be challenging. For example, students start the year at different skill levels, and they all face different factors inside and outside the classroom that affect how they learn. At its core, valueded is a way of addressing these challenges. The District of Columbia Public Schools is interested in using this information to determine how the transition to virtual learning from the COVID pandemic has affected student are whement while controlling for outside factors.

Determining the measure of a teacher's impact on a student's learning can be challesging well. VAM addresses these challenges by estimating a teacher's impact on student learning over the course of the school year, as evidenced by a standardized assessment, by taking into account other factors such as a stand's incoming test scores, special education status, and eligibility for free or reducer meals, to name a few.
